Guidance for Youth Members

Remember the Code of Conduct for youth members which you and your parents must read and accept on webcollect before becoming members.

Parents and guardians of applicants under 18 yr. of age are warned that the club is only able to provide safety facilities during the hours of organised club sailing activities. Outside these hours parents and guardians have sole responsibility for their children and wards.

I also understand that my child must always wear a suitable buoyancy aid when sailing from the club.

Always wear a buoyancy aid and shoes when sailing or on the slipway.

Always wear adequate clothing for sailing

Between October and Easter and in cold weather this should include a wet or dry suit and hat.

On shore

- Always behave in a responsible and sensible way in the clubhouse (no chasing/running, bikes, ball games and skateboarding)
- Always keep your clothes and other stuff tidy in the clubhouse.
- Be careful and no running on the slipway because it can be very slippery, and the water becomes suddenly very deep off the edges and the bottom end.
- Do not block the slipway or leave your boat with the sails up.
- Do not go swimming at the club.

On the water

Date of Issue: February 2021

- On club days you are only allowed to sail with the Race Officer's permission **and** there is a safety boat on the water.
- Always sail behind moored boats, and never play on them.
- You should only fun sail in the area between Rowan Point and the Gardd Fon, in sight of the club.
- Club boats are only for use during organised sailing sessions, see the instructions about booking and using club boats.

If in doubt ASK.
